2. Rules:

All IWWF Golden Wake Tour competitions will be carried out according to the rules of the IWWF Wakeboard World Council. Please note, a suitable helmet and a life vest (jacket) have to be worn during all competitions. Actual version of IWWF rules can be downloaded from this link:

Rules will also be available by Chief Judge at the competition site.

3. Riders' duties:

All riders must be registered for each competition in time via the IWWF competition homepage on myzone.cablewakeboard.net.

All riders have to start in an official competition jersey (BIB), which will be provided by the organizer. Deposit for BIB is 25Eur.

4. Categories:

Each category requires a minimum of 3 riders

Wakeboard:

- U15 Boys and Girls
- U19 Junior Men and Ladies
- OPEN Men and Ladies
- O30 Masters Men

Wakeskate:

- OPEN Men and Ladies

6. Tour ranking:

Sum of the best 4 results of each rider in each age category will be used for IWWF Golden Wake Tour 2018 final ranking. In order for a category to be ranked in the final tour-ranking it is mandatory to open the category during at least 3 of the competitions.

In case of a tie between riders in the final ranking, the following rules will be applied to determine higher ranking:

1. Rider, achieving more higher results within IWWF Golden Wake Tour 2018 (maximum 4 best results)
2. Rider placing higher at the final IWWF Golden Wake Tour 2018 competition.

Based on the placing in each category, rides will be awarded with the following ranking points

1. place – 100 points
2. place – 93 points
3. place – 86 points
4. place – 79 points
5. place – 73 points
6. place – 68 points
7. place – 63 points
8. place – 58 points
9. place – 54 points
10. place – 50 points
11. place – 46 points
12. place – 42 points
13. place – 39 points
14. place – 36 points
15. place – 34 points
16. place – 31 points

18. place – 27 points
19. place – 25 points
20. place – 23 points
21. place – 21 points
